Request for a permanent no access status for your thesis, dissertation, or problem report (ETD) due to export control regulations

From the West Virginia University Electronic Thesis and Dissertation Policy:

The permanent no-access status secures the entire work from public and campus access. The title, abstract, and associated metadata (date of graduation, degree type, college, department, committee membership) will remain publicly available and discoverable. A student may not select embargoed status in lieu of obtaining appropriate copyright permissions as theses and dissertations are intended to be public record of examination documents.

The student, with approval from the student's advisor and a signature obtained by an export control officer, must select a no access distribution for the ETD due to export control regulations. Examples include the International Traffic in Arms Regulations, 22 C. F.R. pts 120-130 or the Export Administration Regulation, 15 C.F.R. pts 730-774.

The student and their advisor acknowledge that the document is subject to the relevant export control regulations, and access must be approved by the Export Control Office. The Export Control Office may impose additional restrictions, such as in-library use, at their discretion.
